1. Eligibility Criteria

1.1 General Requirements

Candidates shall produce the following documents in original along with one set of self-attested photocopies:

- (a) Photo Identity Proof (Passport/Aadhaar Card/PAN Card)
- (b) Proof of Permanent and Present Residential Address
- (c) Proof of Age (Admit Card or School Leaving Certificate issued by a State/Central Board)

1.2 Essential Requirements

Candidates should possess the following qualifications:

1. VICT/TOTA/TOTI certificate (to be obtained within six months of joining the Institute, if not already possessed).
2. Valid INDOS Number, Passport and CDC.
3. Must have held a rank **not below Petty Officer in the Indian Navy or Bosun (Serang) on a Merchant Ship.**
4. Ex-Indian Navy candidates applying for Seamanship Instructor shall possess **Seamanship Instructor Qualification.**

2. Duties and Responsibilities

The selected candidate shall be responsible for:

1. Instructing students and assisting faculty members in workshops, simulators and other practical training activities.

2. Maintenance, augmentation and upkeep of GSK workshop equipment, machinery and training devices.
3. Conducting practical and theoretical training for Merchant Navy trainees/cadets.
4. Assisting in project-related work assigned by the Institute.
5. Staying overnight at the campus on a rotational basis, as directed by the Institute, and assisting the Warden Instructor in hostel/warden duties.

3. Age

Preferably **below 60 years** as on the date of the interview.

4. Remuneration

- **Consolidated Pay:** ₹30,000/- per month
- **Special Pay:** As admissible under the rules of the Institute.
